Types of Cambodian Visas

Diplomatic Visa (A)

A diplomatic visa may be issued to holders of diplomatic passports and their dependants if they are entering Cambodia to carry out official diplomatic missions. This visa may also be granted to holders of diplomatic passports if they visit Cambodia in their private capacity. A diplomatic visa is identified by the capital letter $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$.

Official Visa (B)

This visa is granted to foreigners entering Cambodia to perform missions with governmental international organizations whose status is recognized by agreements with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation. This visa is also granted to foreigners holding official passports on non-official business. An official visa is identified by the capital letter $\underline{\mathbf{B}}$.

Courtesy Visa (C)

Courtesy visas are granted to visitors and their dependents in situation which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and/or other ministries regard as acts of politeness or courtesy. A courtesy visa is identified by the capital letter $\underline{\mathbb{C}}$.

Tourist Visa (T)

A tourist visa is issued to foreigners who enter Cambodia for private, tourist and sightseeing purposes. A tourist visa is identified by the capital letter $\underline{\mathbf{T}}$.

Transit Visa (D)

This visa is granted to foreigners transiting Cambodia on route to a third country or a member of a crew. A transit visa is identified by the capital letter \underline{D} .

Ordinary Visa (E)

This visa is granted to foreigners who don't meet the conditions for any of the above visa types, including business people, students and labor migrants. The applicants need to have sufficient evidence to prove they require this type of visa. The visa is identified by the capital letter $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$.

Special Visa (K)

This visa is granted to person whose original nationality is Cambodian and holding a foreign passport. A special visa is identified by the capital letter K.
